#### **Old Business:**

- Website
  - Discussion on delegation of administrative rights for website updates and changes.
  - Decision made to have one chief designee for each of the 5 subsections. That chief can delegate access to their staff to make appropriate changes to their subsection.
  - Any glitches found or immediate changes to be made should be sent to Josh Chadwick.
- Dispatch RFP
  - o Waiting on money to be released, which should be in December.
  - Chief Concepcion will have something for the group to review at the November meeting.
- Policy and Procedure
  - Ready to proceed with finalizing all draft sections.
- Gang of Five / Homeland Security Grant Program
  - Will be putting together a meeting later this month with Holly Powers from Solano OES to discuss needs and available money.

#### **New Business:**

- Meeting Minutes
  - Minutes will be condensed and put on the website.
- UASI Discussion Follow-up from Law Enforcement meeting
  - There was a lot of discussion with the police chiefs at the meeting about taking advantage of the available funding. The funds need to be better utilized by increasing participation.
  - Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> is the annual kickoff meeting on the scope of projects to be considered on the Bay Area UASI.
  - Chief MacArthur and Don Ryan will be going to the meeting to bring up that Solano is looking at a communications project.
- Election of new Area Coordinator
  - Nomination was received for Chief Concepcion.
  - Discussion on having too few alternate coordinators; becomes problematic when alternates leave for strike teams.
  - o Agreement that there need to be two officially named primary alternates and at least 4 or 5 other alternates/duty coordinators to assist with all the other duties.
  - Motion to appoint Chief Concepcion as Area Coordinator by Chief Lydon, seconded by Chief Munn. All in favor. Motion approved.
- 7-Day Minimum
  - Discussion on whether or not the current criteria for a 7-day minimum rotation for strike teams should be modified to a 3 or 4-day rotation.
  - Motion to vote on status of 7-day rotation to remain with current criteria and added to policy by Chief Lydon, seconded by Chief Martin. Fairfield, Benicia,

Cordelia, Vacaville, Rio Vista, and Travis in favor. Montezuma, Suisun City, Suisun District, Vacaville District, and Vallejo opposed. Motion approved.

- SCBA Grant (added to agenda)
  - The SCBA Grant scoring process has been changed this year and FEMA encouraged us to apply again and they will assist us through the process.
  - Those interested in applying again are Vacaville, Fairfield, Cordelia, Vallejo, and Rio Vista.
