#### **New Business:**

- Meeting Updates
  - July 5 meeting canceled HazMat meeting to be canceled as well
  - o August: 6-month check-in with Law Enforcement moved to Vacaville
    - Potential dates Not August 9 because it is FRI
    - August 2 is a potential date and Vacaville could host
    - Potentially move the check-in meeting to September
  - October meeting moved to Travis AFB
- SCFCA Guidelines Approval
  - Motion to approve SCFCA Guidelines by Chief Chadwick seconded by Chief Concepcion. All in favor. Motion Approved.
- Update from OES Region II Meeting
  - Chief Chadwick provided updates and deadline reminders from the OES Region II Meeting (attached)
- Rescue Team Funding
  - Homeland Security 17 funding \$40,000 in USAR and \$20,000 in Water Rescue to be used by May 2020. Funding is available now.
    - Fairfield \$30,000
    - Vacaville \$15,000
    - Benicia \$15,000
    - Cordelia for 4 new gas monitors (if they qualify) will come out of Fairfield
    - If it is training, the request needs to be send in to Holly prior to the training, how many people, and how much money
  - \$4,000 in CERT to Benicia
  - HazMat Challenge members were added so the number will be \$25,000
  - Sim Table \$63,000 currently allocated but updated quote is \$68,000 to include a HazMat-specific training. There is an annual maintenance fee for \$10,000.
