✓ Draw down expectations (Not leaving your city unstaffed to provide mutual aid) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Years ago, County Chiefs committed to not abandon their jurisdiction to go help (day to day mutual aid) due to no move up and cover system<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ CFD – only 1 unit currently, will strip agency to provide MA○ BNC currently does strip for neighbors, using CCC for coverage most of the time○ A county-wide move up & cover needs to be developed○ OES – Move up & cover issues arise with the way CAD is currently set up, really need a consolidated dispatch to work correctly• Recent orders for resources did not get completed on the Quail, Nelson, and Quail 2 fire<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Dispatch did follow matrices to the best of their abilities during the incidents○ Matrices are the issue, not the dispatch center – Dispatch needs to be included on discussions/decisions for how to move forward○ AVL/closest unit is best way to achieve what we want○ Many units do not have AVL currently, especially districts○ units are shown as available even if unstaffed due to need for CAD to show available units for calls –<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ VAC asked if possible to only request physically staffed units – it may be possible with new availability definitions in CAD –	Luckenbach

- FFD asked about potential to keep incidents in their PSAP through 4th alarm before sending to Solano – More issues and confusion happens when incidents are sent to Solano later in the incidents

Releasing of mutual aid units-(Units from farthest away typically get released first)

- Reminder to try to relieve units according to distance from incident – releasing furthest out units first

Area of responsibility vs. Matrix utilization (which matrix do we use, where the fire started or where it is?)

- Regardless of 1st on scene we should be operating off of matrix where incident is located (City or district)

- ✓ County Restat (See attached Draft) Matcham
 - Solano dispatch manages the list
 - enter “turndown” as the incident name and date if turned down
 - Adjust B1 language to allow for dept that require BC to manage
- ✓ Post Incident Decon (See attached Draft) Munn
 - Ready to forward to FC’s
- ✓ Rehab Update (See attached Draft) Munn/Matcham
 - C1-EMS should be clarified with ALS ambulance
 - Need clear triggers on when to activate rehab
 - Reword to be “if med Evals are required due to complexity, then an additional resource ordered”
 - Have IC make the need for rehab decision based on complexity of incident
