Guideline Name:	Size Up & Arrival Reports

Purpose: To standardize the size up and arrival report process of all first arriving resources on an emergency scene. Consistent size up and arrival report methodology will provide a framework to establish incidents action plans early. A mental size up should be performed by all personnel upon arrival of any scene, regardless of arrival sequence. Size Up should be ongoing as conditions change.

Size Up

Size Up is the continuous *mental* process of analyzing the situation:

- Facts, Probabilities, Own Situation, Decision, Plan (FPODP)
 - Evaluate the situation and its potential size and complexity
 - Identify all hazards
 - Determine risk to life and property

The information gathered in the initial arriving Size Up will be used to establish the Incident Action Plan. (Reference: SCFCA Command SOG)

Arrival Report

An Arrival Report is the *verbal* radio transmission of the first-arriving unit on scene. Initial Arrival Reports will contain the following information in order:

- 1. **Identify:** the arriving unit and confirm location (if different than dispatched address)
- 2. **Object**: a brief description of the incident is (building / vehicle / topography)
- 3. Conditions: a brief description of what the incident is doing
- 4. Actions: declaration of incident priority, strategy, objectives and command mode
- 5. Needs: incident needs including additional resources

Additional Reports

The following information should be reported on the radio

- Change in Incident Priority
- Change in Incident Strategy
- Tactical benchmarks are met
- Significant scene hazards
- Transfer of command
