- Lithium fire – working on AAR, gar fire, fully engulfed, dispatch advised of lithium while responding, rashes, fatigue, N/V, immediate to 3 days later for symptoms, 13 patients, may not have been lithium exposure, most issues with those not in "IDLH" (standing by, cops, run-off, etc)
