The group talked about the potential benefits of conducting quarterly trainings for all the departments to participate in. The group agreed there was a benefit of getting all the departments together to work on lesser used skills and treat some of the trainings like a readiness drill.

- **FRF** will host the first drill in 2020.
 - Firefighter Survival – Individual Stations to focus on different skill sets

 - *Class room session on facility operations*
 - *Facility tour and expectations during a large-scale incident*
 - *If weather conditions allow, conduct live-fire training on flammable liquids props.*
